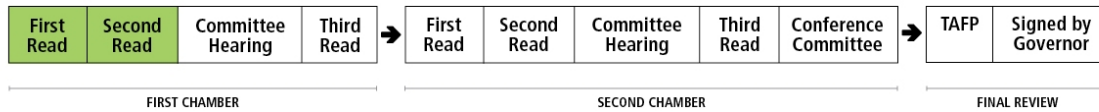
HB 266 **Brattin** Tenure: Eliminates tenure for new employees at public institutions of higher education and specifies information that public institutions of higher education must make available to the public.

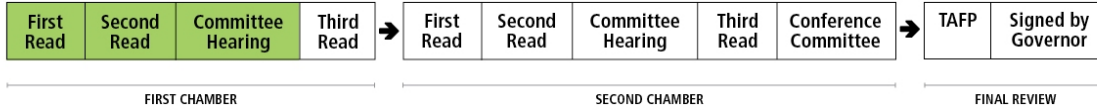


<p>HB 690 White</p>	<p><u>Medical school student placement</u>: No health care provider shall enter into a contract for the placement of medical school students with a medical school located outside the state of Missouri to the exclusion of Missouri medical school students.</p> <p>Committee:</p>
