Background

- Five of six performance funding measures certified by CBHE in December
- Graduate outcomes measure lags other measures to allow sufficient time for follow-up
- Methodologies differentiated by sector



Graduate Outcomes Measures

Public Universities:

- Administer the NACE First Destination Survey to bachelor's and associate degree completers.
- Completers are marked successful if employed full-time, participating in a voluntary service program (e.g. the Peace Corps), serving in the military, or enrolled in continuing education within six months of graduation.



Graduate Outcomes Measures

Community Colleges and MSU-West Plains:

 Completers are marked successful if competitively employed, serving in the military, or found in state wage records within six months of graduation, or enrolled in continuing education within 12 months of graduation.

State Technical College:

 Completers are marked successful if competitively employed, serving in the military, or enrolled in continuing education within six months of graduation.



Graduate Outcomes Success

Institutions must account for at least 60 percent of undergraduate completers.

Improvement can be based on the current three-year rate compared to the previous three-year rate, or at least 75 percent successful (sustained excellence).

completions per FTE student

pass rates on assessment or professional licensure exams

graduate outcomes

MSU-West Plains:

three-year graduation and transfer rate

pass rates on professional licensure exams

graduate outcomes

State Technical College:

three-year graduation rate



- 24 institutions met at least one measure (100 percent)
- 22 institutions met two measures (92 percent)
