Background

Passed by General Assembly and signed by Governor Parson in 2019

Program components

- Reimburse cost of tuition and fees for dual credit or dual enrollment coursework
- Recipient must meet requirements for A+ eligibility
- Coursework must be offered by institution of higher education or vocational/technical school
- Reimbursement on the basis of financial need



TAB 1

Background

Unfunded until FY 2022

- \$5M in separate A+ line
- Dedicated to dual credit/dual enrollment program

Program start delayed until Spring 2022 (January 2022)

Sought feedback from

- A+ dual credit/dual enrollment working group
- State Student Financial Aid Committee
- Presidents and Chancellors

Next Steps

- File proposed rule with Secretary of State
- Rule review by Joint Committee on Administrative Rules
- File Final Order of Rulemaking
- Rule effective 30 days after publication in Code of State Regulations





Population by Race and Hispanic Origin











Education Attainment

Population Age 25 and over













Education Attainment by Race

Bachelor's Degree or Higher



High School Graduation Rates


Public High School Graduation Rates, 2019-2020








Percent of All MO FAFSA Filers




Percent of First-Time MO FAFSA Filers

Total Undergraduate Headcount MO Public Institutions, Fall 2018-2020




