College Access Challenge Grant

- Sub-grant program
 - 25 submitted proposals; 11 funded
 - \$900,000 distributed this year
- High school financial literacy materials
 - 38,000 sets planned
- Website enhancements
 - Higher education portal for families

CBHE Initiatives

- Clarification of Bright Flight statute
- Transfer of statutory authority
 - Minority Teaching Scholarship
 - Minority and Underrepresented Environmental Literacy Program
- Change to Access Missouri inflationary adjustment

2010 Legislative Session

Possible Proposals

- Missouri Promise/A+ expansion
 - A+ scholarship/reimbursement for any public high school graduate
 - “Completer” scholarship
- Consolidation of state SFA in MDHE
- Access Missouri award revision

2010 Legislative Session Budget Outlook

- FY 2010
 - Receipts down from FY 2009
 - Additional withholdings/reductions unlikely for current year
- FY 2011
 - Stable receipts but substantial revenue shortfall
 - No increase budget request

Access Missouri Update

- 09-10 final awards = 78% of statutory maximum
 - Public 2-year maximum = \$780
 - Public 4-year and Linn State maximum = \$1,680
 - Private maximum = \$3,590
- Funding and award amounts re-evaluated in December

Bright Flight 2010-2011

- Top 3% = Up to \$4,000 annually
 - ACT Score 31
 - SAT Scores
- Top 4-5% = Up to \$1,000 annually
 - ACT Score 30
 - SAT Scores
- In FAMOUS by January 2010

 - Vietnam Veteran's Survivors Grant (6 CSR 10-2.130)




Administrative Rule Changes
