

PARTNER TALKING POINTS

- 1. A new state financial aid program that addresses workforce needs by encouraging adults to pursue a certificate, degree, or industry-recognized credential in an area designated as high need.
- 2. Fast Track is designed to ensure that tuition and fees are fully covered (when combined with other federal and state financial aid programs).
- 3. This program takes a broad view of workforce development and reflects the actual needs of business and industry by providing resources for students to pursue a comprehensive set of training and education paths.
- 4. By securing a credential, employees have the opportunity to advance turning the job they do into a career where they are more likely to be satisfied.
- 5. Productivity is enhanced when workers are confident in the knowledge and skills needed to perform their tasks.
- 6. A more skilled workforce creates more competition for highly skilled positions which, in turn, gives businesses access to a bigger net of qualified candidates.
- 7. Having a quality, readily-available workforce is the most important factor to drive economic development in Missouri communities.
- 8. Employees will not have to travel far to obtain their credential because of the wide variety of postsecondary institutions offering Fast Track programs.
- 9. A wide variety of Missouri post-secondary institutions are eligible so employees will not have to travel far to obtain their credential.
- 10. Opportunity for advancement is a benefit directly related to employee satisfaction. Providing employees with information on the Fast Track program can create loyalty and promote retention.
