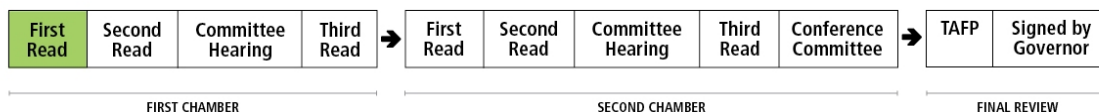
HB 367 **Newman** Enough is Enough Act: Requires higher education institutions to adopt sexual assault policies which contain certain enumerated requirements.

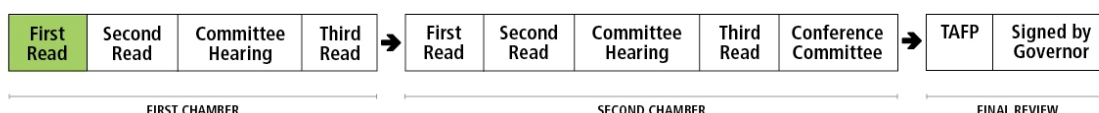

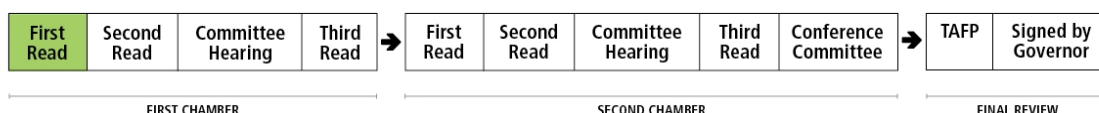
HB 472 **Smith** College Credit Disclosure Act: Requires a higher education institution to disclose to students before enrollment that it is not regionally accredited.

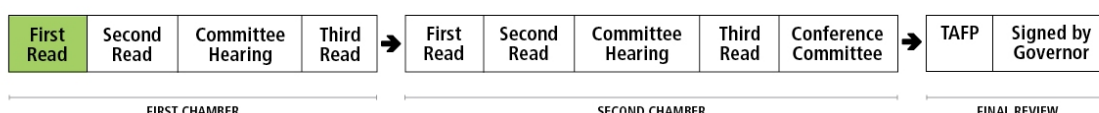
SB 52 **Nasheed** Suicide Awareness and Prevention: Creates several provisions relating to suicide awareness and prevention.

SB 53 **Nasheed** Affirmative Consent: Requires higher education institutions to inform students and employees about affirmative consent to sexual activity.

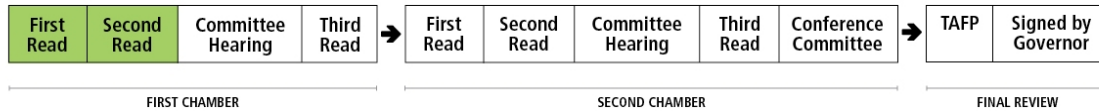

Summary of Legislation Impacting Higher Education Employees

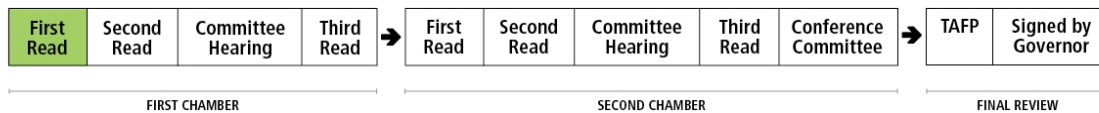
HB 266 **Brattin** Tenure: Eliminates tenure for new employees at public institutions of higher education and specifies information that public institutions of higher education must make available to the public.

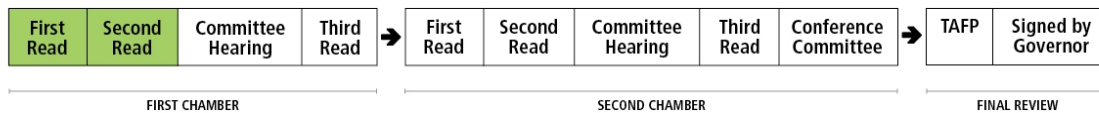

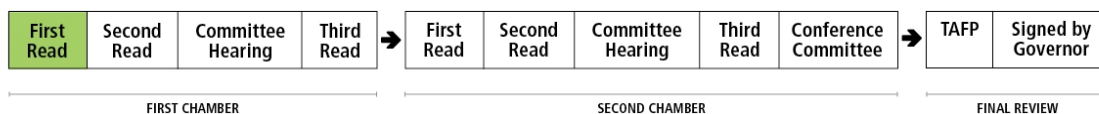
HB 316 **Pike** Psychologist Licensure: Modifies provisions relating to education and experience requirements for the licensure of psychologists
