Estimate Percentage of Credit Hours that will be assigned to full time faculty:

Full-time faculty teach 12 credit hours or less in a given session. Adjunct faculty can teach no more than 9 credit hours in a given session, and no more than 6 in-seat credit hours a session.

Expectations for professional activities, special student contact, teaching/learning innovation:

Full-time faculty members are required to participate in professional development, for promotion, tenure, and annual evaluation, and have department, school and college budgetary support available. Adjunct faculty members are required to provide contact information to students. Full-time faculty members are required to have 3 hours a week of office hours designated for their students.
