Update on Implementation of New Laws

BACKGROUND

The Regular Session of the 102nd General Assembly began on Wednesday, January 4, 2023, and concluded on Friday, May 12, 2023. For bills that were agreed upon and passed during session, the Governor had 15 days to sign or veto the bills. For bills that were agreed upon and finally passed and delivered to the Governor after session concluded, the Governor had 45 days to sign or veto the bills.

CURRENT STATUS

Laws passed that require implementation/action by the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development:

- House Bill 3 – DHEWD Budget Bill
- House Bill 5 – ITSD Budget Bill
- House Bill 17 – Reappropriation Budget Bill
- House Bill 19 – Planning and Capital Projects
- House Bill 20 – ARPA Budget Bill
- House Bill 402 – Health Care
- House Bill 417 – Upskilling
