Academic Program Actions on Provisionally Approved Programs

Coordinating Board for Higher Education
December 6, 2023

BACKGROUND

Section 173.005, RSMo, authorizes the Coordinating Board for Higher Education (CBHE) to approve proposed new degree programs, as well as to collect data on and recommend the consolidation or elimination of programs in the best interests of the institution and/or state. The CBHE approves new academic programs provisionally for a period of five years, after which time the Missouri Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development (MDHEWD) staff reassess the programs and make recommendations to the CBHE to approve fully, not approve, or review again in two years.

CURRENT STATUS

The CBHE gave provisional approval to the programs listed below in 2017 and 2018. MDHEWD staff has reviewed each program and recommends the board take the following action:
