Dear Colleagues:

In my letter dated November 30, 2011, I informed you that the average tuition for 2011-12 as defined in the HESFA and CBHE policy would be \$6,496.20. After a few updates and some corrections of fees the average tuition for 2011-12 as defined in the HESFA and CBHE policy is actually \$6,482. Below is an updated list showing where institutions fall in respect to the average tuition for 2011-12.

Institutions that have higher than average tuition:

- Northwest Missouri State University
- Truman State University
- University of Central Missouri
- University of Missouri
- Southeast Missouri State University


Institutions that have lower than average tuition:

- Harris-Stowe State University
- Lincoln University
- Linn State Technical College
- Missouri Southern State University
- Missouri State University
- Missouri Western State University

The final CPI number needed to calculate the limit for the upcoming year is scheduled to be announced January 19, 2012, at which time letters will be mailed to each four-year institution plus Linn State Technical College detailing their respective maximum increase and the criteria we expect to be addressed in any waiver requests.
