Dear Commissioner Russell:

The University of Missouri's tuition and fee rates effective with the 2011 summer session have been established by Board of Curator action. The rates for resident undergraduate tuition and required fees under SB 389 have been adjusted higher than the one-year change in the consumer price index. The increase for a University of Missouri resident undergraduate averages at 5.5%, with a range from 4.7% to 6.6%, depending on the campus. Table 1 shows tuition and required fees for a Missouri resident undergraduate student as defined by SB389.
