Linda Luebbering has worked in budget related positions for the State of Missouri for 20 years. From 2002 to 2004, she was the state budget director for Governor Bob Holden. Prior to returning to Missouri as state budget director for Governor Jay Nixon, Luebbering served as the fiscal management director for the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare. Luebbering received a bachelor's degree in economics and a master's degree in public administration from the University of Missouri-Columbia, graduating *summa cum laude* in 1990. In 2002, she was awarded the George A. Bell Service Award by the National Association of State Budget Officers for outstanding service in state budgeting.



Brenda Norman Albright is a consultant who uses information in support of planning, strategic decision-making, funding formulas and policies, and performance in higher education. In the past few years, Albright has consulted in more than 25 states and with several national organizations. She has also served in several senior administrative positions in higher education. Most recently, as the executive director of the National Postsecondary Education Cooperative, she provided leadership in developing new initiatives in the areas of state and institutional performance indicators, student success and other activities designed to improve decision-making at the national, state and institution levels. She also served as deputy executive director and chief finance officer of the Tennessee Higher Education Commission.



Jane Wellman is the executive director of the Delta Project on Postsecondary Costs, Productivity and Accountability, an independent non-profit research and policy organization focused on ways to improve public transparency about higher education finance including comparative data on cost metrics. She is widely recognized for her work in public policy and higher education with particular expertise in state fiscal policy; cost analysis; strategic planning; state and federal regulation of higher education; accountability metrics and performance reporting; and quality control including accreditation. In addition to her work with the Delta Project, Wellman also serves as the executive director of the National Association of System Heads, and is on the board of directors for the Association of American Colleges and Universities.
