Helping Missouri students  
access higher education

Missouri's Journey to College initiative helps students prepare for postsecondary education. Sponsored by the Department of Higher Education, the initiative includes three outreach programs to assist students and their families with planning and paying for college.



Outreach events are hosted annually by high schools, colleges and college-access organizations. The events are open to all students but focus on removing barriers to higher education for students who are low-income, are underrepresented in higher education and would be the first in their family to attend college.

## 1. Apply Missouri

Apply Missouri helps students find the "best fit" for higher education and provides time during the school day for seniors to submit college applications.

The program promotes a college-going culture and helps create important communication channels between students and colleges.

High schools host events during September and October to ensure every senior has an opportunity to receive hands-on assistance with the college-application process.



## 2. FAFSA Frenzy

FAFSA Frenzy provides free professional assistance to help students and their families fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

The FAFSA is the primary form used by federal, state and higher education institutions to determine eligibility for grants, scholarships, loans and work-study programs.



Realize your dreams

Three steps can put you on the path to earning a college degree.

**STEP 1**  
**Apply**

The best time to apply to college is the senior year. Think about the kind of degree you want and the type of school you need to attend.

**Apply Missouri**  
Many high schools host Apply Missouri events in the fall and October to provide time during the school year to complete applications to colleges you are interested in.

**Things to bring:**

- A completed Student Admissions Application
- A USB drive with essays or personal statement
- Credit card information to pay college application fee (or request a fee waiver from your school counselor)

**STEP 2**  
**Fund**

College costs can vary depending on the school you attend and the type of degree you are seeking. Many students receive financial aid to help fund their education.

Be sure to fill out the Free Application for Student Aid. The FAFSA is required for most federal, state and college financial aid, including grants, scholarships, work study and student loans.

**Apply** The best time to apply to college is the fall of your senior year. Apply Missouri can help you learn more about higher education options and submit college applications. Finding the best fit for you will help you succeed in completing a degree or certificate.

**Fund** Many students receive financial aid to help fund their education. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is required for most federal, state and college financial aid. FAFSA provides free one-on-one assistance to help you complete the application.

**Decide** Whether you choose to attend college or enter the military, it is important to finalize and follow through on your plans for the future. Celebrate your decision alongside your peers during Decision Day. If you haven't made plans yet, now is the time!






# Apply Missouri registrations YTD






